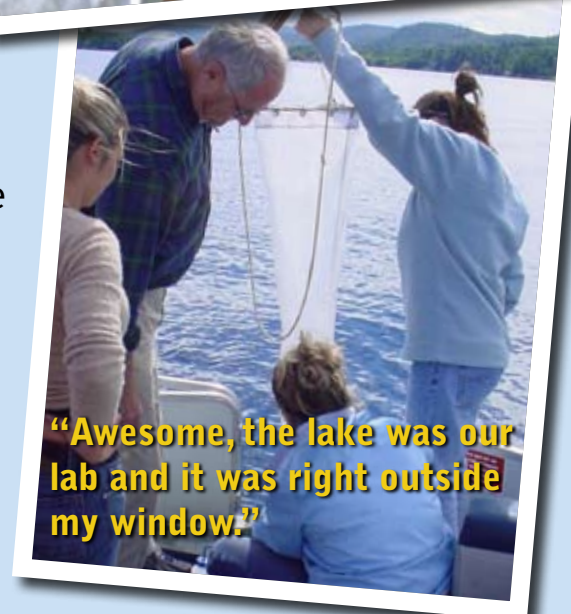
Classroom theory in the environmental sciences is integrated with field studies and real-world environmental issues.
