  - Architecture applicants should submit a creative portfolio by November 2 (Early Decision I), December 15 (Early Decision II), or January 15 (Regular Decision). Students with unusually strong academic profiles may be reviewed without the portfolio.

- Official certified academic transcripts must be translated into English and sent directly from your secondary school to Rensselaer Admissions.
