

Mobile Computing Program – EDUCATIONAL SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENTS

1. Microsoft Campus Agreement Student License Confirmation

The acceptance form is valid for the Microsoft products listed below, which shall be referred to collectively herein as the “Software.” Software is made available to each User because Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute (Rensselaer) has purchased license coverage for the Software through the Microsoft Campus Agreement Subscription Student Option. Under the terms of this subscription, Rensselaer is extending to each User the right to use the Software on a personally-owned notebook computer. The User DOES NOT OWN the license; rather, they have a limited right to use the license while they participate in Rensselaer’s Mobile Computing Program. The User will be required to remove the Software from their personal computer immediately when they are no longer a registered student at Rensselaer, or upon expiration of Rensselaer’s subscription.

Upon the User’s graduation, the Microsoft Software license will convert to a perpetual license, meaning that they own the Microsoft Software license as verified in their Student License Confirmation, which the User may obtain from Rensselaer at that time upon their request. The Student License Confirmation is proof of the User’s right to use the Software license.

A. Grant of License

Licensors hereby grants User the right to run one copy of the version number and language of the Software Product(s) identified below which have been installed on the User’s computer per the right granted to them by Rensselaer under the Campus Agreement Program. 2. Mobile Computing Program Software Suite Use Agreement

I certify that I am a registered student at Rensselaer and request use of Software licenses for the programs listed below for my laptop computer. Access to the Mobile Computing Program Software Suite* licenses is provided upon condition of my acknowledgement and agreement to the terms and conditions of use as cited below and at the respective publisher’s websites. I agree to review and abide by the terms of the license agreements of the software publishers listed during my career at Rensselaer. I understand that these additional Software products must be removed from my computer when I am no longer a registered student at Rensselaer.

A. Grant of License

As licensee, Rensselaer grants access and academic use to the User of a single (1) license. The license will be limited to academic or research activity. Any form of commercial activity is prohibited.

The User is not obtaining title to the Software or any copyrights. The User is prohibited from selling, sublicensing, renting, leasing, conveying, modifying, translating, decompiling, or reverse engineering the Software for any purpose.

The User may not give or distribute the Software to any other party or post to public sites. Such action is considered a violation of the license grant and Rensselaer Computer Use policy (<http://www.rpi.edu/web/comec/>) with subsequent resulting penalties. The User acknowledges that use of Software is limited to the Rensselaer campus located in Troy, New York. Off-campus use is strictly limited to directly-related Rensselaer projects. The User agrees that when they are no longer a registered student at Rensselaer, the licensed Software must be removed from the User’s computer.
