- Non-U.S. citizens must submit photocopies of official immigration/visa documents.
- If you have a possible interest in obtaining a graduate degree in the future, we suggest providing all credentials and the Statement of Background and Goals at this time.
- The number of credit hours taken as a non-matriculated student that each department accepts toward its degree varies; the university-wide maximum is 12 credit hours. The department determines which courses taken as a non-matriculated student will count toward a degree.
