

Scholarships for the Class of 2009

The New York Water Environment Association, Inc. The NYWEA will be offering a total of six \$1,500 scholarships: Two (2) to children of NYWEA members, two (2) to students enrolled at a college or university where there is a NYWEA chapter, two (2) to high school students who will be enrolled in an environmentally related program in a four year college or university. **Applications are in the Guidance Office and are DUE TO NYWEA BY JANUARY 22, 2009.**

SEFCU Smart Sense Awards. Apply for one of several \$1,000 and \$500 scholarships. Awards are open to all college-bound high school seniors who are SEFCU members. **Applications are in the Guidance Office and are DUE JANUARY 23, 2008.**

Zonta International Club of Albany Young Women in Public Affairs Award. A young woman will be recognized for their leadership, community service, and essay content. Applicants must reside or attend school in Albany, Rensselaer, or Saratoga County. **Applications are in the Guidance Office and are DUE TO THE ZONTA CLUB BY FEBRUARY 27, 2009.**

Dorothea Dietz Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship is sponsored by women in physical education in New York State to provide financial assistance to selected women students planning to major in Physical Education Teacher Education. The amount of these scholarships varies from year to year, but it is expected for 2009 that they will be in the amounts of \$7500, \$6500, and \$5500. **Applications are available at www.nysahperd.org and are DUE BY MARCH 1, 2009 to our area chairperson.**

American Legion Auxiliary Scholarships: Candidate for all of these awards shall be daughters, granddaughters, great-granddaughters, sons, grandsons, or great-grandsons of veterans who served in the Armed Forces during WWI, WWII, the Korean Conflict, Vietnam War, Grenada/Lebanon, Panama, and the Persian Gulf War. ALL APPLICATIONS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE GUIDANCE OFFICE AND HAVE A DEADLINE TO THE CHAIRMAN OF MARCH 1, 2009.

Department Scholarship: \$1000 to an eligible candidate who will further his/her education. Other restrictions may apply. See application for details.

Department District Scholarship: \$1000 to an eligible candidate will further his/her education. Other restrictions may apply. See application for details.

Past Presidents' Parley Scholarship in Medical Field: Three \$1500 scholarships awarded to eligible candidates planning to further his/her education in the medical field. Other restrictions may apply. See application for details.

Raymond T. Wellington Memorial Scholarship: \$1,000 to a candidate who plans to further his or her education. Other restrictions may apply. See application for details.

The 1st Lieutenant Michael L. Lewis, Jr. Memorial Fund Scholarship: Candidates for this award must be members of the American Legion Auxiliary. Two scholarships will be awarded: one to a Junior Member in his or her senior year and one to a Senior Member who is continuing his or her education. If there are no Senior applications, two Junior scholarships will be awarded. Other restrictions may apply. See application for details.
